3. Because Jesus has already taken my punishment.

"The wages for sin is death..." (Romans 6:23, ESV).

"It is finished" (John 19:30, ESV).

4. Because Jesus understands my human weaknesses.

"For we do not have a high priest who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but one who in every respect has been tempted as we are, yet without sin" (Hebrews 4:15, ESV).

5. Because God doesn't hold on to grudges.
