### Splendid Snowballs!



This process art is fun to create and gives the artist gross-motor workout! Partially fill the foot of a knee-high stocking with rice or dry beans; then tie a knot in the stocking just about the filling. To make a print, hold the loose end of the stocking and dip

the stuffed end in a shallow container of white paint. Gently bounce the stocking on a sheet of paper to make snowball-like prints. Then sprinkle glitter on the wet paint. For added fun, fill the toe of a stocking with bells instead!

### Snow Writing



Pour salt (snow) into a box lid, piling it up at one end to make a snowbank. Place several letter cards nearby. A youngster chooses a card and stands it in the snowbank. Then he uses his fingertip to practice

writing the chosen letter in the shallow snow, smoothing out the snow each time he is finished writing the letter.

### Itsy-Bitsy Snowman (sung to the tune of "The Itsy-Bitsy Spider")
