#### STEPS TO SALVATION DRILL

#### WHAT WE BELIEVE DRILL

***What does the Bible say about the authority of the Scripture?***

The instruction of the LORD is perfect, renewing one’s life; the testimony of the LORD is trustworthy, making the inexperienced wise. The precepts of the LORD are right, making the heart glad; the command of the LORD is radiant, making the eyes light up. **Psalms 19:7–8**

***What does the Bible say about who Jesus is?***

“But you,” He asked them, “who do you say that I am?” Simon Peter answered, “You are the Messiah, the Son of the living God!”

**Matthew 16:15–16**

***What does the Bible say about our mission on earth?***

“Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe everything I have commanded you. And remember, I am with you always, to the end of the age.” **Matthew 28:19–20**

***What does the Bible say about sharing your story of faith?***

“But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come on you, and you will be My witnesses in Jerusalem, in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.” **Acts 1:8**

***What does the Bible say about believer’s baptism?***

Therefore we were buried with Him by baptism into death, in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, so we too may walk in a new way of life. **Romans 6:4**

***What does the Bible say about the security of the believer?***

For I am persuaded that not even death or life, angels or rulers, things present or things to come, hostile powers, height or depth, or any other created thing will have the power to separate us from the love of God that is Christ Jesus our Lord! **Romans 8:38–39**

***What does the Bible say about obeying authority?***

Everyone must submit to the governing authorities, for there is no authority except from God, and those that exist are instituted by God. So then, the one who resists the authority is opposing God’s command, and those who oppose it will bring judgment on themselves. **Romans 13:1–2**

***What does the Bible say about your money?***

For it is written, Be holy, because I am holy.

**A Psalm of Praise**

<sup>1</sup> Shout triumphantly to the LORD, all the earth.

<sup>2</sup> Serve the LORD with gladness; come before Him with joyful songs. <sup>3</sup> Acknowledge that Yahweh is God. He made us, and we are His —His people, the sheep of His pasture. <sup>4</sup> Enter His gates with thanksgiving and His courts with praise. Give thanks to Him and praise His name. <sup>5</sup> For Yahweh is good, and His love is eternal; His faithfulness endures through all generations. **Psalms 100**

**God Knows Me**

<sup>1</sup> LORD, You have searched me and known me.

<sup>2</sup> You know when I sit down and when I stand up; You understand my thoughts from far away.

<sup>3</sup> You observe my travels and my rest; You are aware of all my ways. <sup>4</sup> Before a word is on my tongue, You know all about it, LORD. <sup>5</sup> You have encircled me; You have placed Your hand on me.

<sup>6</sup> This extraordinary knowledge is beyond me. It is lofty; I am unable to reach it. <sup>7</sup> Where can I go to escape Your Spirit? Where can I flee from Your presence? <sup>8</sup> If I go up to heaven, You are there; if I make my bed in Sheol, You are there.

**The Beatitudes**

<sup>3</sup> “The poor in spirit are blessed, for the kingdom of heaven is theirs. <sup>4</sup> Those who mourn are blessed, for they will be comforted. <sup>5</sup> The gentle are blessed, for they will inherit the earth.

<sup>6</sup> Those who hunger and thirst for righteousness are blessed, for they will be filled. <sup>7</sup> The merciful are blessed, for they will be shown mercy. <sup>8</sup> The pure in heart are blessed, for they will see God.

<sup>9</sup> The peacemakers are blessed, for they will be called sons of God. <sup>10</sup> Those who are persecuted for righteousness are blessed, for the kingdom of heaven is theirs. <sup>11</sup> “You are blessed when they insult and persecute you and falsely say every

kind of evil against you because of Me. <sup>12</sup> Be glad and rejoice, because your reward is great in heaven. For that is how they persecuted the prophets who were before you. **Matthew 5:3–12**

**The First Lord’s Supper**

<sup>17</sup> Then He took a cup, and after giving thanks, He said, “Take this and share it among yourselves. <sup>18</sup> For I tell you, from now on I will not drink of the fruit of the vine until the kingdom of God comes.” <sup>19</sup> And He took bread, gave thanks, broke it, gave it to them, and said, “This is My body, which is given for you. Do this in remembrance of Me.” <sup>20</sup> In the same way He also took the cup after supper and said, “This cup is the new covenant established by My blood; it is shed for you. **Luke 22:17–20**

**A Christian’s Armor**

<sup>13</sup> This is why you must take up the full armor of God, so that you may be able to resist in the evil day, and having prepared everything, to take your stand. <sup>14</sup> Stand, therefore, with truth like a belt around your waist, righteousness like armor on your chest, <sup>15</sup> and your feet sandaled with readiness for the gospel of peace. <sup>16</sup> In every situation take the shield of faith, and with it you will be able to extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one. <sup>17</sup> Take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is God’s word. <sup>18</sup> Pray at all times in the Spirit with every prayer and request, and stay alert in this with all perseverance and intercession for all the saints.

**Listening and Doing**

<sup>19</sup> My dearly loved brothers, understand this: Everyone must be quick to hear, slow to speak, and slow to anger, <sup>20</sup> for man’s anger does not accomplish God’s righteousness. <sup>21</sup> Therefore, ridding yourselves of all moral filth and evil, humbly receive the implanted word, which is able to save you. <sup>22</sup> But be doers of the word and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves.
